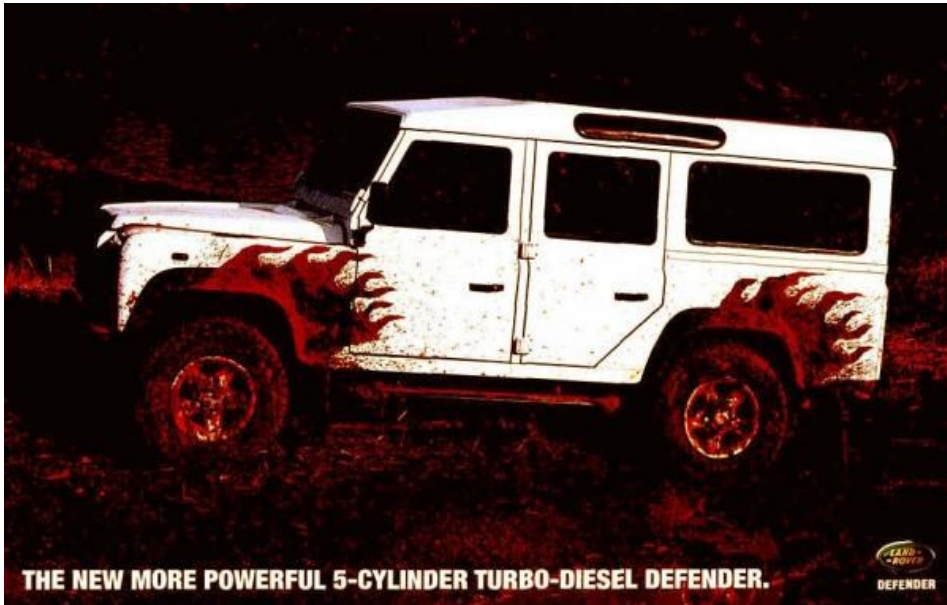

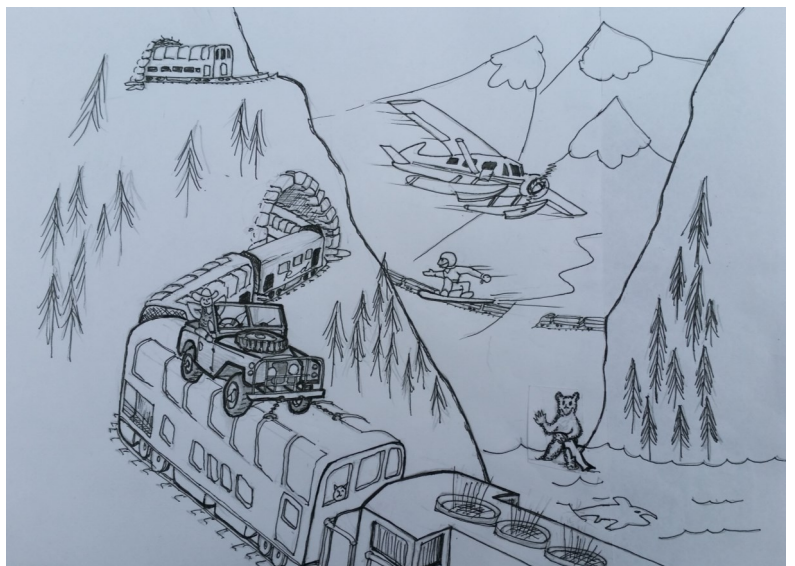

## LAND ROVER'S 70TH BIRTHDAY IN AUSTRALIA

COOMA SHOW GROUND, NSW.

Friday 30th March to Monday 2nd April, 2018

### SAVE THE DATE

Plans are underway for the celebration of Land Rover's 70th birthday. Following on the success of the 60th, we have been welcomed back to Cooma by the Snowy Monaro Regional Council and the Cooma Car Club for a four-day event over Easter 2018. With Land Rover's close ties with one of the world's greatest engineering feats, the Snowy Mountains Scheme, it's fitting that we should return to Cooma.

Land Rover Australia have already signed up as a key sponsor, and as in past events will have all the latest models on display.

All sorts of events are being planned by the sponsors and organisers, the Land Rover Owners' Club of Victoria, The Land Rover Owners' Club of Sydney, the Range Rover Club of New South Wales and the Land Rover Club of the ACT. The 60th in 2008 event attracted over 750 Land Rovers and nearly 1,400 enthusiasts. The organisers of the 70th are hoping for 1,000 Land Rovers. Any owner of any type of Land Rover or Range Rover, be it modified or un-modified, old or new, in original condition or fully restored should attend. But you really need only to be a Land Rover lover – you don't have to own one to enjoy the weekend.

Activities at the 70th will include:

- Displays by trade exhibitors.
- Trips of varying standards in and around the Cooma and Snowy Mountains district.
- A motorkhana.
- One (and possibly 2) Terrapod test tracks, supplied by Land Rover Australia.
- The Grand Parade of Land Rovers through the main streets of Cooma.
- A swap meet.
- Demonstrations of recovery techniques.
- Attractions for the children.
- A Gala Dinner with award presentations, with guest speakers.

The time has come for all those Land Rover lovers who have been putting off restoring their beloved old vehicles to get to it.



### Paper work for trip leaders and participants.

Following discussions with Wayne Hevey, CEO Four Wheel Drive Victoria, it seems we need to improve some of our trip details.

The extra paper work is so that individual club members, any trip visitors and the club as a legal entity are fully covered and safe.

The changes are:

**Personal Details Forms** — Personal Details Forms should be used on ALL trips not just overnight trips. There should be two copies of the form for each person in the vehicle. The form should be up to date and in a sealed envelope with the full name clearly printed on the front. At the start of the trip one envelope for each person should be given to the Trip Leader. The second copy should be kept in the glove box or centre consol box of the vehicle. At the conclusion of the trip the Trip Leader will return the forms to the participants. If there is a circumstance where emergency service personnel are involved and an injured or unwell person cannot give their own details or may be suffering from shock and confused, the Trip Leader should make sure the unopened envelope goes with the patient.

**Temporary Membership** — If you have a friend or guest come along on a club trip, in order for them to be covered by Four Wheel Drive Victoria's insurance, they must fill in a form. The form should be filled in before the trip starts and a fee of \$11 is made to cover the one off insurance cost. The form and money is to be given to the Trip Leader who will pass it on to the LROCG Treasurer. The form and fee will be sent to Four Wheel Drive Victoria as soon as possible.

**Trip Intensions Forms.** At meetings, these sheets can be filled in by people, intending to go on advertised club trips. These give the Trip Leader contact details in case the trip has to be postponed or cancelled or meeting place arrangements are changed, etc.

**Trip Participants Forms.** — These are the normal sheets that are filled in at the start of a club trip. The only difference is that now there is a column for ticking when the Personal Details Forms have been collected. After the trip the Trip Leader can pass the sheets on to the Trip Coordinator.

The forms and lists, plus originals for photocopying replacements when we run out, will be kept at Gippsland Land Rover and available at LROCG meetings.
